We are also strongly encouraging everyone to get a flu shot this year. Attached is a flyer with free immunization events next week, sponsored by TUSD and the Pima County Health Department. These free clinics will be able to administer the vaccines your student requires. The clinics are also open to any other member of your family who needs an immunization, including the flu shot. They will vaccinate all family members regardless of age. Please call the health office if you need a copy of your child's immunization record. Please take your immunization record with you to the clinic.

According to Arizona State law, children are still required to have their immunizations up to date whether they are in-school learning or virtually learning. We hope these clinics will help you meet the immunization needs of your student and your family.

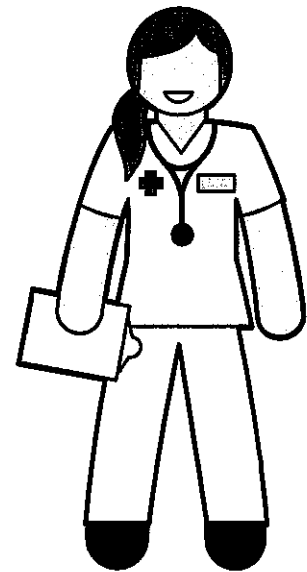

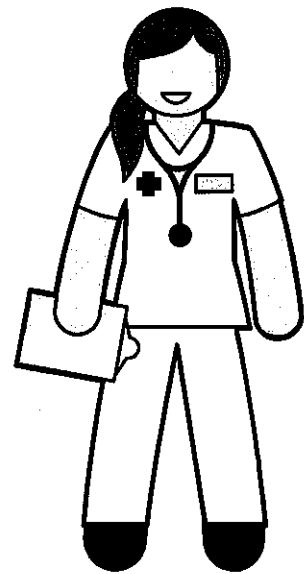
